Strengths (including why)

You were given a very short time in which to deliver this session, and you did a SUPERB job of making it feel substantive yet not rushed. Further - you did all this with people moving several times and coordinating among about 6 co-presenters. Very impressive job of identifying what people needed to know in order to effectively engage, and then setting them up in activities where they could elevate their knowledge via interaction from very simple prompts.

Areas for Improvement (including how)

Some of the small group leaders presenting about their own innovation took up quite of bit the discussion time describing what they did. I feel that it may have been more valuable to have them state just one "paragraph's worth" of additional illuminating information (similar in amount to what was displayed as the session began) and then jump into Q&A.

Insight (including significance)

It would be interesting to try and figure out how the presenters themselves could learn as much from the session as those attending.
