Abstract:	The workshop will highlight the current research on the key risk factors that exists for matriculating college students. The participants will rank existing identified risk factors with additional factors that should be added from their individual institutions. In the analysis, the weighting of how significant each factor is to the total risk will be determined. The resulting data will be analyzed and contributed to the proceedings where a final synthesized set of risk factors with contribution weightings will be determined.
