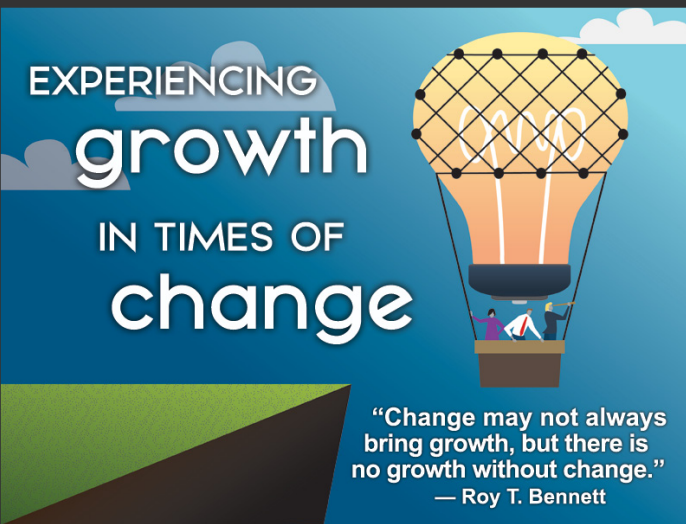

CONFERENCE THREADS

- **Plenary Sessions/Symposia** — These 90-minute sessions provide for a group to come together and design a symposium to address a specific aspect of one of the Conference Goals.
- **Workshop: Practitioner- or Research-Focused** — These workshops are 75-minute explorations of current practice OR scholarship with an eye to advancing pertinent research (additional projects, collaboration, and publications).
- **Research Paper Sessions** — These discussion sessions include a selection of three papers focused on a particular theme. Authors will present a 10-minute overview of their paper and then participate in a facilitated 60-minute discussion with session participants.
- **Hall of Innovation (Poster Session)** — These asynchronous sessions center on a specific teaching innovation or design that can be shared via a brief video and PowerPoint slides.
